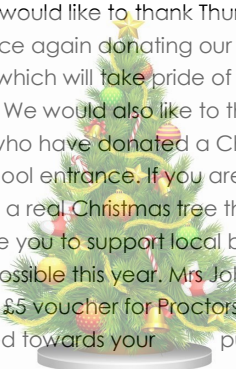

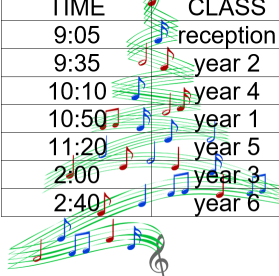
Wednesday 16th Dec– **PSA funded Special visitors from N. Pole (Y3,Y4,Y5,Y6)**
