Theme: Weather and seasons

Learning Stimuli: Local walk

Helping Lights Shine for All

The children will be learning about the seasons and why they change throughout the year. We will be looking at how the days become shorter throughout autumn and winter and why this happens. We will also be looking at weather patterns in the UK and how weather patterns change.

As global citizens and change-makers (History, Geography, RE & P4C): We will be looking at the, UK what it stands for and the countries in it. We will then be looking at the weather patterns in the UK and discussing how we can measure different types of weather. In RE we will be looking at different festivals and why we celebrate them. We will also be going to the Methodist church to talk about why we celebrate Christmas.

As scientists and problem-solvers (Science, Maths and Computing): In science we will be looking at the different seasons. We will be looking at the months in each seasons and discussing the weather throughout the seasons and why we have changes throughout the year.

As communicators & collaborators (Literacy, Art, Music & MFL): In literacy we will be reading Stig of the dump and then developing our story, letter and instruction writing. In art children will be creating their own cave art linking to our topic using a variety of techniques. This half term children will be experiencing a French day where a variety of different activities will be provided in a carousel between classrooms. In Music children will be learning songs for Christingle.
