Term-time holidays

It is very important that following all of the disruption during Covid, we now prioritise children being in school as often as possible.

Taking holidays in term time can affect a child's education as much as any other absence and we would appreciate parents' help by not taking children away in school time. There is no automatic entitlement in law to time off in school time to go on holiday and family holidays are not considered to be "exceptional circumstances" therefore these cannot be authorised by the school and may result in penalty notices being issued under Section 444(1) of the Education Act 1996. This is in line with Staffordshire County Council's Code of Conduct.
