St Luke's Shared Reading Cycle Year 2 - 6

<u>Intent</u>

Children will have targeted reading sessions to develop accuracy, automaticity and prosody of word reading.

Children will hear this through effective teacher modelling strategies and will have opportunities to rehearse and improve their own word reading. This will allow access to all abilities.

Children will develop higher level vocabulary through exposure to high quality texts and through exploration of meaning.

Children will understand how to answer of range of questions to aid their comprehension of a text.

Children will be able to answer a range of questions about fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

Children will be exposed to high quality texts which are connected to their wider curriculum learning, to help weave threads in their understanding and embed knowledge.
